34,000 Churches of The National Black Church Initiative Calls Mark Halperin A Sexual Predator And A Hypocrite

He talked about equality and at the same time brutalized women

Washington DC – The National Black Church Initiative (NBCI) a faith-based coalition of 34,000 churches comprised of 15 denominations and 15.7 million African Americans, say this is a typical example of the highest form of hypocrisy that exists in our media. Individuals who say that they are objective, and fair-minded journalists are themselves guilty of the same thing they accuse others of and get on television to act sanctimonious.

Mr. Halperin supported gay marriage with all of his other liberal friends and also cursed the Church every time we raised our heads to object to same-sex marriage. Now, he expects us to overlook his sexual abuse of women and say nothing. We will not do this because largely NBCI has been very consistent at calling out ministers from the Catholic and Protestant Churches when they have abused children, women and abused their moral authority.
